

WGC 2023 Tomato Varieties

Early Girl Indeterminate, 59 days

This variety starts bearing fruit earlier and produces for longer than other medium-sized tomatoes. Always a reliable variety for early season fruit with good flavor.

Fourth of July Indeterminate, 49 days

Celebrate the Fourth of July with a plentiful harvest of vine-ripened red, luscious tomatoes. The indeterminate plants produce plentiful 4 oz. tomatoes all season long, the perfect salad tomato.

Cosmonaut Volkov Determinate, 72 days

Plants set generously sized, 2–3 inch, slightly squat, deep orange/red fruit with green-tinged shoulders, and bright red interiors with rich, deep, balanced sweet and tangy flavor.. A taste sensation that only an heirloom can offer. Territorial Seed Company's Great Northwest Tomato Taste-Off winner.

Ruby Crush Determinate, 65-70 days

A sweet, flavorful grape tomato. These compact plants are high yielding, producing single and double trusses of 1 ½ inch long and 1 ¼ inch wide, scarlet fruit. The firm grapes hold well on the plant. An excellent option for small gardens and container growing.

Sweet Million, Indeterminate, 65 – 75 days

Very disease resistant plants produce 1–1 ½ inch fruit in grape-like clusters with exceptionally sweet taste. Prolific yielder that sets clusters with 20 - 30 deep red fruits. Easy to grow; good shelf life. Early maturity.

Sungold, Indeterminate, 65 days

Beautiful cherry tomato that ripens to a golden orange. The Sun Gold Cherry is possibly the sweetest cherry tomato around. Plants bear lots of fruit and ripen early, continuing to produce throughout the season. A single large plant has produced over 1,000 tomatoes! A perennial favorite!

Pomodoro Squisito, Indeterminate, 72 days

A true fingertip-kissing sauce tomato! This San Marzano hybrid produces heaps of luscious fruit for all your sauce, ketchup and soup needs. Vigorous plants set heavy clusters of 6-8, elongated deep red fruit with thick meat, a minimal seed cavity and well-developed flavor. Excellent resistance to blossom-end rot for a San Marzano type.

Tiny Tim, Determinate, 60 days

Early, dependable, tree-like, rugose-leaved dwarf plants are perfect for small gardens and containers. Only 15" tall, yet yields many small 3/4" fruits. Super in salads.

Sweet Tangerine, Determinate, 68 days

This tomato features clean, bushy, plants that are quite disease resistant and set very heavy crops. Fruits are a beautiful dark orange color with a sweet complex flavor, low in acid. One of our most popular varieties.
